




WHO WE ARE

We are a faith-based multicultural volunteer clinic. Volunteer providers are all board-certified MDs, Nurse Practitioners, and/or Physician Assistants.

Specialty Care includes: Cardiology, Endocrinology, Gastroenterology, Orthopedics, Internal Medicine, Optometry, Ophthalmology, Neurology, Women's Health & Wellness, Geriatrics, and Primary Care.

Other Team Members include: Registered Nurses, Diabetic Educators, Translators, Medical Assistants, Scribes, Pre-Med and Nursing Students, Prayer Ministers

WHAT WE DO

- Appointment-Only
- Basic medical care and medication management
- Diabetic Care and Education
- Vision Testing and Lens Refraction
- Referrals for Imaging and other required services

OUR NEEDS

Volunteer Physicians, PAs, NPs, RNs, and translators.

As an all volunteer clinic, we welcome monetary donations for lab services and operating expenses.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Patients must be residents of Collin County and must be able to present proof of residency.

Acceptable Documentation:

- Photo Identification Card
- Utility or Phone bill with name and address
- Cell Phone Number

Patient must not have health insurance of any kind; this includes Workers' Compensation, Disability, Medicaid/Medicare, or VA Benefits.

All Patients must be 18 years or older.

New applicants and existing patients MUST have a specific health complaint to schedule an appointment.

We DO NOT perform routine physicals, routine labs, emergency or urgent care, or any prenatal/pregnancy-related care.

Any patient who forfeits 3 appointments within a 12 month period without notifying the center of the need to cancel will not be rescheduled.
